

OT Technician Course 2nd to 3rd April 2016

The course was held on **2nd - 3rd April 2016** under auspices of World Orthopaedic Concern (WOC - Int.), Orthopaedic Research & Education Foundation - India & Centre for Science and Society, Indore at Arihant Hospital & Research Centre, Indore, India. 65 O. T. Technician attended the course. The course was inaugurated by Dr. Prakash Bangani, Chairman of the hospital and Mrs. Maya Vijay Nair, Chief O. T. Sister, All India Institute of Medical Sciences, New Delhi, India was the guest of honor and chief instructor. With her chief O. T. Supervisor Mr. Rambharose, Arihant Hospital, Indore was the main faculty. They were supported by senior surgeons of the hospital.

All the aspects related to OT like OT design, discipline, sterilization, scrubbing, gowning, gloving, laying of trolley and assisting the surgeon were demonstrated practically. Other aspects of the OT like, maintenance of OT table, lights, positing of patients, tourniquet, painting and draping were demonstrated. It was also demonstrated how to take care of the instruments and other gadgets like caturey, suction machine, IITV, pneumatic instruments and Anesthesia work station. The special session was arranged on dressing material, plaster technique, suture and needles.

The last session was practical demonstration of Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation by Prof. K. K. Arora, HOD Anesthesia department, MGM Medical College, Indore and his team. This demonstration was greatly appreciated. All surgeons also attended this session.
